Dear Colleagues,

On behalf of the Congress Faculty, we are pleased to invite you to the 4th Swiss DiabetesTech Symposium on September 3rd, 2026, at the Inselspital in Bern.

Continuous glucose monitoring has become the standard of care in type 1 diabetes and increasingly used in type 2 diabetes. Automated insulin delivery (AID) systems from several manufacturers—each with its own algorithm and logic of interaction between sensor, pump, and user—can reduce hypoglycemia, improve time in range, and ease the daily burden for people with diabetes. But the benefit is not automatic. It depends on how well specialists understand each system and how carefully settings are adapted over time.

Initiation is only the beginning. Turning a functioning device into effective therapy requires ongoing optimization: basal rates, insulin to carbohydrate ratios, correction factors, active insulin time, and algorithm targets all need regular reassessment as a person's life, activity, and physiology evolve. Supporting people with diabetes in choosing, using, and adjusting these systems demands solid knowledge of each platform.

The morning program provides exactly that. Parallel, hands on sessions will cover the four AID systems currently used in Switzerland—Tandem, mylife, Medtronic, and Insulet Omnipod—led by experienced clinicians in German and French and repeated throughout the morning so participants can attend the sessions most relevant to their practice.

The afternoon features plenary lectures on situations where algorithms reach their limits and clinical judgment becomes essential: skin reactions, AID use in pregnancy, exercise, very low or very high insulin needs, and adjunctive pharmacological therapies.

Helping people with diabetes get the most out of AID systems requires deep understanding. This symposium is designed to strengthen that understanding and translate it into daily clinical care.

We look forward to welcoming you to Bern on September 3rd, 2026.

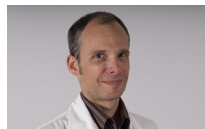
